



## NCREIF Fall Conference 2021 COVID Information

As of September 1, 2021 – NCREIF is carefully monitoring the COVID situation as we move toward the dates of the Fall Conference. Florida does not currently have any vaccination or masking requirements, and as of July 1, 2021 businesses are not permitted to require vaccination or proof of vaccination.

**NCREIF's position for the Fall Conference is that we recommended attendees take any and all precautions they deem suitable for their personal circumstances and the safety of others.**

All social events are scheduled outdoors, weather permitting, and we will try our best to spread attendees out inside the meeting rooms as much as possible.

NCREIF will have a COVID waiver sent to all registered attendees for signature prior to the conference.

NCREIF and the Fontainebleau have reviewed the hotel's sanitation protocols and they are shown below:

The safety and security of all Guests, Visitors and Team Members remains the highest priority at Fontainebleau. We have developed Bleu Clean, a comprehensive, multi-point health & safety program with:

- AM~PM DOC on Property: To address medical needs immediately, Fontainebleau guests have the option to use SKYDOC 24-hours a day to communicate via their computer/cell phone or schedule a doctor visit in the comfort of their hotel room.
- Public restrooms are equipped with touch-free devices, including sink, soap and paper towel dispensers.
- Touch-less hand sanitizer dispensers are located throughout the hotel.
- Thorough employee training and reinforcement of personal hygiene on proper handwashing and use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers. Personal Protective Equipment for Team Members, including masks and gloves, are provided as needed.
- Increased cleaning and sanitization protocols, utilizing the highest level of disinfectants.

We will continue to monitor the COVID situation as we approach the conference dates and will keep you apprised of any new developments, though none are expected at this time.
